 The Village 2.0 and The Blueprint 2.0 App were developed and designed by a team of educators, strategists, and human resource analysts to address the academic, socioemotional, and socioeconomic disparities faced by both urban and rural youth.

# The Blueprint 2.0 App is a technological engagement solution that uses an algorithm to match students with great teachers who can address their unique needs. The App:

- Provides ongoing online solutions that will be used to survey, test, and engage the youth.
- Is an online solution to address racial and socioeconomic and school access inequities with a goal of improving academic performance.
- Tracks student progress with a digital dashboard containing data such as how many students are participating with mentors, family engagement events, mentor and teacher involvement, as well as parent follow-up time.
